All contest flights on Sunday must be in the air by 8:00pm. The digital clock displayed on the large scoreboard will be the official contest clock. NOTE: We must be out of the building by 10pm on Sunday			

All AMA events to be flown per current AMA and FAI rules. All AMA events will be listed on the contest sanction. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place certificates will be presented only for the events listed above.

No-Cal Scale: no weight limit, per FAC rules except scoring will be best 1of 5

Phantom Flash and Embryo Endurance: per FAC rules except for scoring which will be best 1 of 5

JETCO ROG: Best 1 of 5 flights. Model must ROG. Any type of commercially made plastic prop may be used. Max prop diameter is 5½". Props may be cut down, sanded, or scraped. Wing and tail outline per plan. Motor stick must be solid wood. Dihedral amount and type may be changed. Must be tissue covered. No camber or baggy tissue on wing. Any type of thrust bearing may be used. Wire sizes may be changed. No minimum weight. The plan for the JETCO ROG may be downloaded from <http://www.indoorfreeflight.com/jetco.html>

Ross Flyer: Best 1 of 5 flights. Tissue covered. Wings and tail per plan. Model must ROG. Landing gear , hook , and prop shaft .025" wire, wing struts .015" wire. Any type of prop OK. The plan for the Ross Flyer is available at www.indoorfreeflight.com/rossflyer.html

Featherette (Indoor Old timer): Model outlines and prop per plan. Rolled tailboom, dual bearing, and tissue tubes permitted. Any type of covering OK. The plan for the Featherette is available at www.indoorfreeflight.com/featherette.html

All events are JSO combined. All contestants must have a valid AMA license.

Entry Fees: Open: \$40.00 Juniors: \$5.00 Contest Sponsors fly for free.

Science Olympiad Teams may fly at \$20 per team and will be restricted to flying on the ends of the building away from the main contest. Due to insurance restrictions with the facility, all flying students must be current AMA members.

You must provide your own tables and chairs if you need them. No helium will be provided. There is a party store nearby that some have had fill their balloons in the past.
