The 2018 Indoor Free Flight World Championship venue will once again host two days of the Jim Richmond Open at West Baden, an AMA sanctioned Cat III contest. Attendees are invited to stay on site at a discounted rate of \$169 plus tax per night (812-936-9300, code 0319IMA). Discounted reservations using the hotel code are only guaranteed until February 23rd. Entry fee is \$55 for adults and \$15 for juniors (18 and under). Pre-registration will be helpful. Helium is subsidized at \$10 for those who have balloons.

Supplemental Regulations:

- 1.) All indoor AMA/FAI events except gliders, electric free flight, and bostonian are welcome to be flown.
- 2.) The contest is open to all flyers holding a valid AMA license and non-US fliers holding valid national licenses from their home countries.
- 3.) The Atrium will be open for flying from 9:00 am until 5:00 pm each day. Planes should be landed by 5:00pm as the air handling system (fans) may be turned on at any time after 5:00pm
- 4.) Helium will be available at \$10 per balloon (including top offs and refills for burst balloons). Steering balloons, when not actively used, should be stored near the Atrium walls.
- 5.) A dimensional and weighing measurement station will be available. Weight checks for those classes with a minimum weight must be made before the first official flight is flown. Dimensional and weight checks must be made after any flight that will be used to apply for a national or world record. The Atrium is a Cat III site.
- 6.) FAI events have 6 flights AMA have 5 official. Once all official contest flights are used, flights may still be attempted for national records. Contest is AMA sanctioned, but NOT FAI sanctioned.
